Thank you very much for your support for Cafe&Wellness Week.

This is Tsuyoshi Sasaki (Mr.) who is CEO of TSO International Inc. which will be held Cafe&Wellness Week from July 1 (Wed) \sim 3 (Fri), 2020 at Pacific Yokohama.

I understand that there is a very tough situation for you due to economic stagnation caused by concerns about the spread of large-scale viruses at this time.

By the way, on February 26, 2020, Prime Minister Shinzo Abe asked organizers of big events scheduled for next two weeks to consider cancelling, postponing, downsizing them to avoid further spread of the new coronavirus (COVID-19). The show management office has been working with relevant organizations to collect information on subsequent regulatory reports.

It is the importance of holding exhibitions which is the most important position for the economic development of Japanese and other countries' industries and the economic activities of each company, so the exhibition will be held as schedule.

The Show Management has been monitoring developments closely with Pacific Yokohama, and we are preparing to hold the exhibition in accordance with the guidelines of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare of Japan.

Measures planned to be implemented during the show (As of March. 3)

- Alcohol-based hand rub will be set at all of the exhibition entrances
- Body temperature measurements by thermography devices at all of the exhibition entrance
- →In case body temperature is 37.5°C(99.5°F) or above, we may reject your entry after you submit health check sheet and go through interview by a doctor or nurse.
- Signboards to recommend Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette, Frequent Hand-washing and Wearing a mask will be put onsite.
- A doctor and nurse will be stationed at the venue during the fair.
- First-aid room will be set up inside the venue.

Please be inform in addition, if the spread of infection continues to spread from late April onwards,

and the government's guidelines in each country request that the event be canceled or that the safety of exhibitors and visitors cannot be ensured, the event may be postponed or the plan may be changed.

In case of postponement or plan change, the show management will announce about two months before the exhibition period.
